Food Donor List for Exempt Special Events

Under the Food Premises Regulation (562), religious organizations, service clubs and fraternal organizations that are exempt must keep a list of all people who donate hazardous food for the special event. Hazardous foods are those that are able to support the growth of disease causing organisms. Hazardous foods are high in protein and moisture. Some examples include: hamburgers, hot dogs, other meat, poultry, fish, eggs, milk, ready-to-eat foods and tofu.
